Περίληψη Πρόσκλησης: This call for proposals aims at co-funding projects developing and promoting

transnational tourism products related specifically to the Cultural and Creative Industries (CCI) subsector 'cultural heritage'. A UNESCO cultural site/s must be the focal point around which the transnational product is built. A particular focus is also being placed on using CCIs-related technologies in promoting these tourism products

and enhancing visitor's experience.

General objectives of this call for proposals are to: Support growth and job creation in tourism and CCIs;

Stimulate competitiveness of the tourism industry, innovation, diversification and

valorisation of European tourism offer;

Develop and enhance synergies between tourism and CCIs; Create a favourable framework to SME's cooperation;

Foster transnational cooperation of all actors along the tourism value chain;

Facilitate long-term European public-private partnerships. The specific objectives of this call for proposals are to:

Strengthen transnational cooperation with regard to European cultural heritage and

tourism;

Raise awareness of European cultural heritage and increase its value, attractiveness

and its potential for the development of the tourism sector;

Encourage the development and diversification of the supply of tourism products and services by enhanced promotion of transnational thematic tourism products

related to cultural heritage;

Strengthen cross-border cooperation and the management skills of public or private bodies in charge of developing and promoting transpational thematic tourism

Περίληψη Πρόσκλησης: Projects shall involve entities from at least two countries, including at least one

Beneficiary State (Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Hungary, Slovenia, Croatia, Romania, Bulgaria, Greece, Cyprus, Malta and Portugal). Each project must include one lead partner and at least one beneficiary partner.

- Eligible lead partner: any eligible entity established in a Beneficiary State;
- Eligible beneficiary partner: any eligible entity established in a Beneficiary State, Ireland, Italy or Spain;
- Expertise partners can be any eligible entity established in a Donor State, in a non-eligible EU Member State or international organisations.
- The Donor States are Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein.

Only entities established in one of the 15 Beneficiary States can apply for funding and perform the tasks of lead partner in the project consortia. There is no limit on the maximum number of beneficiary partners. The establishment of project consortia with more members than the minimum is considered favourable. Eligible project partners may be entities, public or private, commercial or non-commercial and non-governmental organisations, established as legal persons, including but not limited to:

- Municipalities, organisations owned or partly owned by municipalities, associations of municipalities;
- Regions, organisations owned or partly owned by regions; associations of regions;
- Organisational units of central government, organisations partly funded by central government units, state enterprises, state organisations;
- Public and private education and research institutions;
- Civil society organisations, non-profit organisations, social enterprises, interest associations of legal persons, foundations and endowment funds;
- Commercial companies;
- Cooperatives (manufacturing, housing, consumer);
- Business support organisations (incubators, start-up centres, etc.); and
- Social partners (trade unions, sector associations, employer associations, chambers of commerce and industry).

Projects within areas that commonly do not receive EU funding are therefore particularly welcome. The target group of this Fund is young people between 15 and 29, with a special focus on the 25-29 year olds.

Projects developing solutions for the long-term unemployed, discouraged people who have stopped looking for work, inactive women caring for children or incapacitated adults, ethnic minorities including Roma, asylum-seekers, the low-skilled, people with mental health issues and the disabled are particularly welcome

under this call. The Fund aims to advance new and innovative solutions that focus on

the specific needs of the target groups listed above.
